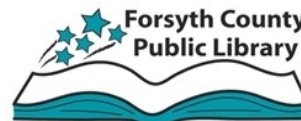

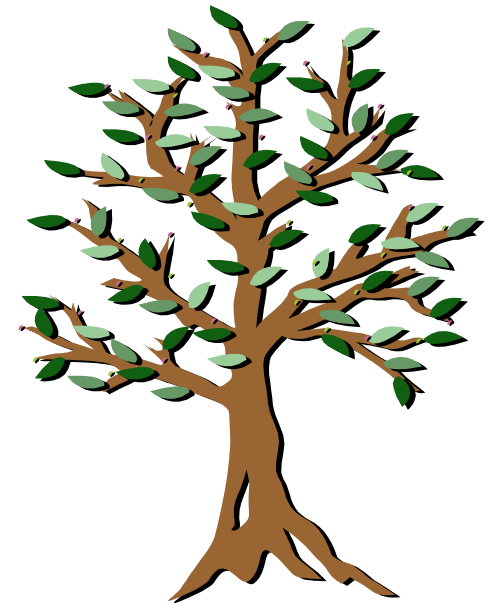

Georgia Research

The metro Atlanta area is rich in institutions and documents that support genealogical research. The Forsyth County Public Library collects materials that instruct patrons in locating and using these resources. The library refers patrons to appropriate institutions and uses interlibrary loan service to assist in obtaining materials.

The Forsyth County Public Library collects materials about Georgia and the library's local service areas, as well as materials written or produced by local authors, when they meet the general selection standards of the library.

Through interlibrary loan we can often borrow materials owned by other library systems. Please be aware, however, that many institutions decline to lend genealogical materials or other materials which are heavily used or are too fragile to mail. Assistance with interlibrary loan requests is available at the Information Desk.



FORSYTH COUNTY PUBLIC LIBRARY RESOURCES

Books in the Forsyth County History Collection are shelved together and have a special Genre label - "Local History." They may be found in the catalog by searching for "Forsyth County History" as a subject. Our Information Staff is available to assist you in locating materials which guide you through the process of researching your family history, including basic resources to help you get started.

Ancestry Library Edition, a GALILEO database available in the library only, is an extensive collection of databases, records, and advice on genealogical research.

HeritageQuest Online, a GALILEO database, has research materials for tracing family lineage and American culture. It includes U.S. federal census records, tax lists, city directories, church and probate records, and more.
